

In Croatian language pronunciation should be easy since we pronounce words as we write them.

There are few letters that might look strange, but here is an explanation that can help you read them:

Č and Ć – pronounce like CH in the English word **CH**ocolate

Đ and DŽ - pronounce like J in the English word Justice

Lj - pronounce like the LLI in the English word mi**LL**ion

Nj - pronounce like NE the in English word **NE**ws

Š – pronounce like the SH in English word **SH**ort

Ž – pronounce like the S in English word pleasure
